From the Northwest

Take Route 10 South to Jefferson (watch it—there is a 90° left turn in the center of town); continue on Route 10 south for 2.5 miles (Route 10 bends to the right and Shew Hollow Road (Route 13) goes straight. Take Shew Hollow to the end (stop sign) and turn right on Route 30; go on Route 30 south for 2.5 miles to 990V. There is a GHS Museum sign on the right.

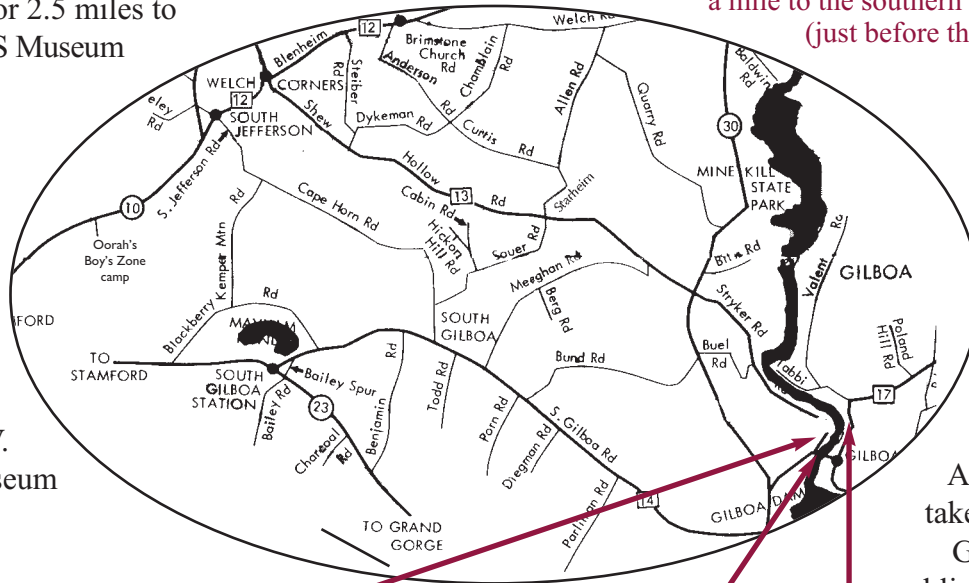
From the North and Northeast

Take Route 30 South past the Minekill State Park and then go 3.7 miles to 990V. There is a Museum sign on the right at the intersection of State Routes 30 and 990V.

Note: GPS has not been updated—due to hurricane Irene, there are two Stryker Roads. To get to the campus, you have go south to **State Route 990V** and then left onto Route 30 for less than a mile to the southern end of Stryker Road (just before the Schoharie bridge).

From the West

Take Route 23 east to Grand Gorge; at the blinker, take Route 30 north 3 miles to Route 990V. There is a GHS Museum sign on the right.



From the East

At Thruway exit 21, take Route 23 West to Grand Gorge; at the blinker, take Route 30 north 2 miles to Route 990V. There is a GHS Museum sign on the left.

Gilboa Historical Society Campus

Our meetings are held regularly on the third Wednesday of each month at the Historical Society Campus on Stryker Road just off 990V, to the west of Schoharie Creek. In the event of snow or ice, they will be held at the Gilboa Town Hall on 990V, about 1000-feet east of the creek.

The GHS Campus includes Gilboa Museum, Nicholas Juried History Center, and Dorothy Cox Juried Pavilion.

Meetings are held from March through December. Each has entertainment at 7, followed by a break for refreshments, and ending with a short business meeting. Meetings typically end around 9.

Exceptions:

The July meeting is a field trip starting at 6, carpooling from the campus to the chosen location. The August meeting is our annual Ice Cream Social, starting at 6 at Dorothy Cox Juried Pavilion. The December meeting is our bottle auction and social, starting at the Town Hall at 7.

Note: GPS has not been updated, so there are two Stryker Roads due to hurricane Irene. To get to the campus, you have to **go east on State Route 990V from Route 30** for less than a mile and enter the southern half of Stryker Road just before you get to the Schoharie bridge.

From the South

Take Route 30 north to Grand Gorge, continue past Grand Gorge 2 miles to 990V. There is a GHS Museum sign on the left.
